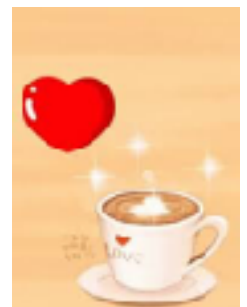
People are being urged to return the £1 coins before they lose their legal tender status. They can either spend them before October 15 or bank them.
