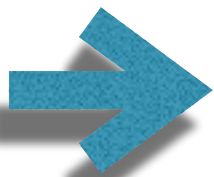

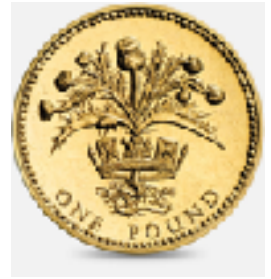


When do the old one pound coins go out of circulation?

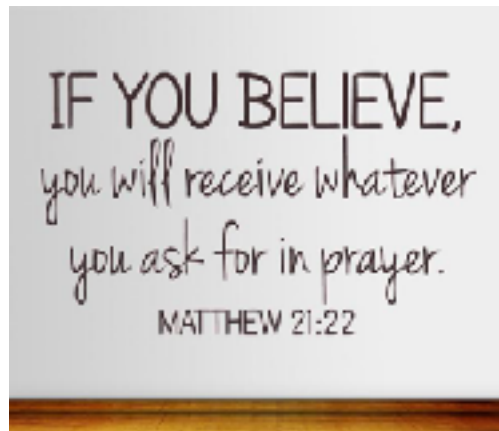


This is an improvement on last year's £563.07 with still a few more waiting to come in.
