

Many of you will know Rupert and I have had the privilege of Tasawer and Rubina with their four children Aaron 13, Mahshameen 11, Anya 8 and David 4 staying with us in the vicarage since last June. We have been so blessed to share our lives together in so many ways this last year.

They came from Pakistan where Tasawer was a Baptist pastor and evangelist. He studied in South Korea having his first degree in English Literature in Urdu! Wow, six languages and such a heart for our Lord Jesus. This is ultimately what meant they had to leave. It was not safe to stay in their home country which they love.

After waiting for many months, they received indefinite right to remain on asylum and human rights grounds. It has been an eye opener to see the journey and patience needed to move forward. Wakefield Baptist church have brought much support and experience to their situation and paper work.

So their next step is west London where they will begin a new season and Tasawer's gifts as pastor/evangelist and linguist can be fully utilised.


