16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence

Mothers' Union campaigns around the world for an end to gender-based violence - violence carried out most often against women and girls because of their gender.

Mothers' Union engages each year with the global 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence, which runs from 25th November (the International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women) and 10th December (International Human Rights Day). We join together with one voice, to call for an end to gender-based violence in all forms, and in all societies.

This year, we focus on the issue of stigma, where society responds negatively to, or by blaming those who are, victims of gender-based violence. Mothers' Union is calling on members and others around the world to talk about gender-based violence, and challenge myths and harmful attitudes around it. We are calling on people everywhere to: break the silence, lift the shame which is often placed unfairly on survivors, and shift the blame from victim to perpetrator.
