School Closure due to Snap Election



Thank you to everyone for their support and understanding regarding the school being used as a polling station for the snap election. We looked into the possibility of remaining open but had to consider several things:-

The lunch time and breakfast club arrangements for the children. The polling station area must be securely isolated from the rest of the school, preventing members of the public coming into contact with the children. The way the public gains access to the polling station must also be considered, for instance the safety of children and parents at the start and end of the school day in car parks and surrounding areas. Although it is often just one room that is used for casting votes, access to toilets, washrooms and drinking water must be unrestricted.
